All bricks will be prominently placed. Special requests cannot be granted for specific locations, colors of brick or type styles. The brick color will be selected by St. Christopher's Inn. Each brick will be engraved with the same typeface. Orders will be accepted at any time. Bricks will be sold until available space sells out.

Please fill in the name or phrase you wish to have on your brick. Print exactly the way you wish your brick to read. All bricks will be printed in uppercase. You may also use numbers for the inscription. All text will be automatically centered on the brick.

You have the option of using up to 3 lines on your commemorative brick or up to 6 lines on your centennial brick. Spacing between words is considered a character; however, punctuation does not require a space.

St. Christopher's Inn, a ministry of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, is a temporary homeless shelter dedicated to the rehabilitation of men in crisis whom we call "Brothers Christopher." Our mission is to offer a continuum of quality health care services that facilitate physical, emotional and spiritual healing by providing chemical dependency treatment, primary health care, and temporary housing. We strive to restore the personal dignity of each individual by utilizing a holistic approach in all our programs. No one is ever turned away because of race, religion or the ability to pay.

The Inn is also home to St. Anthony's Clinic, an OASAS licensed, CARF Accredited substance abuse program. The clinic provides a Day Rehabilitation Program, a Clinical Module Program and an Evening Outpatient Clinic. Our Primary Health Care Services are provided in our Article 28 Clinic, which is licensed by the NYS Department of Health.

St. Christopher's Inn prides itself by simply providing the very best of care. In addition to providing food and shelter, the Inn offers an exceptional chemical dependency treatment program, which includes outstanding supportive services such as acupuncture, yoga, art therapy and vocational assistance as well as a family and GED program.

Our motto at St. Christopher's Inn is "Where Hope and Compassion Meet" and everyday, within every program or service we provide, our community dedicates itself to bringing these words to life.
